

STRAWBERRY TURKEY SPINACH SALAD

Salad Ingredients

5 oz fresh baby spinach 2 c cooked turkey breast (julienned)

2 c fresh strawberries sliced 1 small sweet yellow pepper (julienned)

4 green onions sliced **Dressing**

1/4 cup red wine vinegar

3 Tbsp olive oil

2 Tbsp water

4 tsp honey

1/2 tsp dried minced onion

1/2 tsp salt & pepper

Directions: Place salad ingredients in a large bowl. Place dressing ingredients in a jar with a tight-fitting lid; shake well. Drizzle over salad; toss to combine. Serve immediately.

"Tatay" is what everyone is calling him in our community. Joseph is from the Philippines and "Tatay" is a Tagalog word for


"Dad". He was born in the Philippines and grew up Catholic. In 1970, he migrated to the U.S at the petition of his grandfather, who served in the U.S. Army.
